## Common Basket B Errors

Knee-jerking into Basket A on Basket B or C issues

"Talking the Basket B talk" but "walking the Basket A walk"

"Unilateral compromises"

Neglecting Basket B

Permitting child's response to determine basket placement

Putting behaviours in Basket A that have no business being there

Using Basket B as a last resort

Agreeing to compromises the child can't actually execute
